***Membership is necessary to be eligible to vote for the Board of Directors.***

The Mosier Community School Foundation Inc. and Mosier Middle School are non-profit organizations whose primary activity is operating Mosier Schools (Mosier Community School and Mosier Middle School) as public charter schools. The organizations are governed by a Board of Directors, which are elected by its Members.

What are the benefits?

Eligibility to vote for the Schools' Board of Directors and other matters brought to the membership.

How much does it cost?

Nothing!

Who is eligible?

The following persons shall be eligible to be Members: All adult residents of Zone 1 of the North Wasco County School District #21; parents and guardians of students enrolled at Mosier Schools; Mosier Schools' employees; and active volunteers at Mosier Schools. Individuals eligible to become Members must sign a Statement of Membership and supply the Executive Director or designee with his/her name and address, including e-mail address, if available. A Member admitted automatically shall cease to be a Member if he/she becomes ineligible for membership.

In order to be able to vote in the annual Board of Directors' election, a statement of membership must be signed prior to the opening of the Annual Membership Meeting on May 13, 2015.
